Dear Parishioners,

From last Wednesday members of the congregation are free to sit in any seat in the Church as we begin the process of getting back to normality. For the health and safety of all we will continue to limit the number per seat to 4 except in the case of family members and request people attending Mass to keep a safe distance from the person next to them. When you enter a seat please move to the other end of the seat if there is no one else in the seat or if there are people already in the seat, please move to a safe distance from the person next to you. **Please do not sit on the outside of the seat** as you will be asked to move in as we really don't want people passing each other in a seat at the present time on health & safety grounds. We will continue to have stewards on duty for the immediate future and **we will insist on the congregation wearing masks/visors in Church and sanitising their hands** when entering. People will continue to receive Holy Communion on a row-by-row basis starting at the front and working towards the back following the one-way system already in place. As we can now have far more people in the main aisle, to avoid congestion at the main door in exiting the Church, the Oratory door and the door near the statue of St. Pio will be open after all Masses and we would ask people to use all three doors and limit congestion. As a general rule, please keep a safe distance from the person next to you. There will be further reductions in the role of stewards in the coming weeks and months as we rely on members of the congregation to follow current practices without guidance from the stewards.
