## THE SOLACE CAFÉ

The Solace Café is delivered by AWARE in partnership with St. John of God Community Mental Health Services and the HSE. It is a free out of hours friendly and supportive community service open to anyone from the South County Dublin area requiring mental health support in a crisis. Operating out of the Urbun Café, Unit 2, Watermint, Old Bray Road, Cabinteely, it is open from Thursdays to Sundays from 5.00pm until 10.00pm each week. This is an appointment only service, accepting self-referrals, referrals from healthcare practitioners and community partner agencies. This service is for any adult experiencing a crisis, supporting someone in crisis or experiencing a mental health difficulty that is causing emotional overwhelm or a feeling of being unable to cope.
