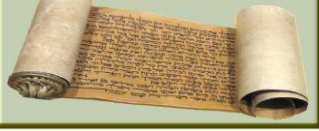

HOUSEHOLD FOOD AND HEALTH STUDY

University College Dublin is currently recruiting Households for the Household Food
and Health Study, which is part of the wider Co-Centre for Sustainable Food
Systems. The study aims to understand how diets, lifestyle and food choices are
changing as people move towards healthier and more sustainable eating habits.

- Participants are aged 4 years or older.
