**WORLD DAY FOR GRANDPARENTS AND THE
ELDERLY**

'I will never forget you' (Isaiah 29:15) is the theme chosen by the Holy Father for the Sixth World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly which aims to emphasise how God's love for each person never fails, even in the fragility of old age. Taken from the Book of Isaiah, the chosen verse is intended to be a message of consolation and hope for all grandparents and the elderly, especially those who live in solitude or feel forgotten. At the same time, it is a call to families and ecclesial communities not to forget them, recognising them as a precious presence and a blessing.

The World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly, which was established by Pope Francis in 2021, is celebrated every year on the fourth Sunday of July, and it is an opportunity to bring the Church closer to the elderly and to value their contributions to families and communities.
